Standardized Assessments

Middle school students will start taking the Smarter Balanced and Oregon Knowledge and Skills (OAKS) Assessments. Both of these assessments (tests) are approved and provided by the State of Oregon to be administered to students in sixth, seventh, and eighth grades. Each of these assessments takes a number of class periods to complete; the only time limit is that once a student starts the test, he/she must complete it within 45 calendar days.

While the sixth grade students are at Outdoor School the week of April 29– May 3, Seventh and Eighth Grade students will begin their standardized state assessments. Sixth grade students will begin their standardized state assessments upon their return from Outdoor School.
