### School Environment

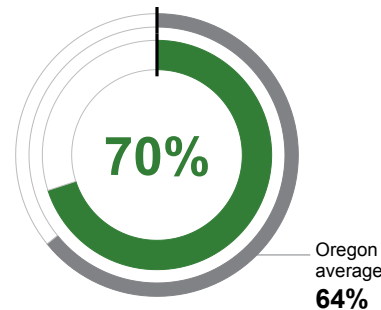
#### CLASS SIZE

#### REGULAR ATTENDERS

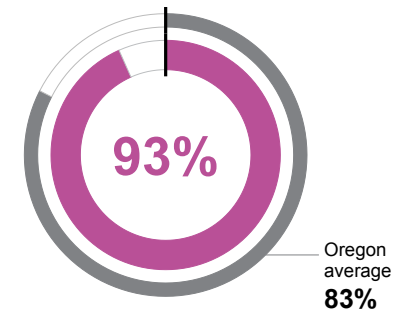
Students who attended more than 90% of their enrolled school days.

#### ON-TRACK TO GRADUATE

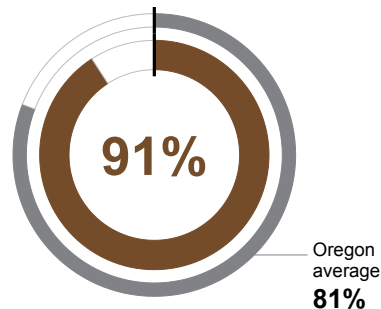
Students earning one-quarter of graduation credits in their 9th grade year.

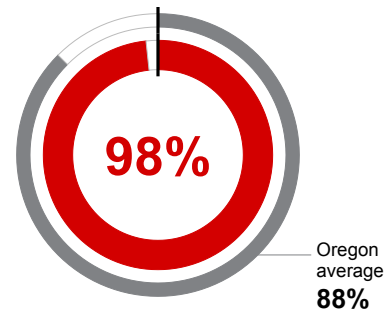
#### ON-TIME GRADUATION

Students earning a diploma within four years. Cohort includes students who were first-time ninth graders in 2017-18 graduating in 2020-21.



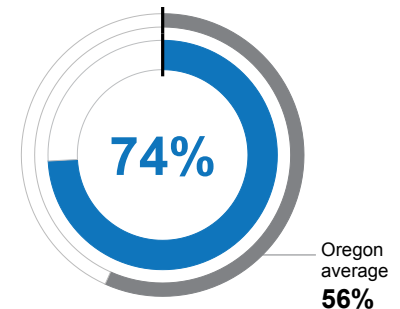
#### FIVE-YEAR COMPLETION

### School Goals

PHS offers a welcoming, safe, and inclusive environment. We value extracurricular participation, wanting EVERY student to find connection with a school-sponsored activity. PHS focuses on dynamic, academic interventions, seeking to increase our on-time graduation rate to 100%. PHS promotes CTE offerings with a focus on completion of CTE pathways. AP offerings include access for underclassmen. PHS communicates, using School Messenger, PHS web page, hallway televisions, weekly newsletter, PHS Twitter and Instagram, and posting daily announcements.

### State Goals

The Oregon Department of Education is partnering with school districts and local communities to ensure a 90% on-time, four year graduation rate by 2025. To progress toward this goal, the state will prioritize efforts to improve attendance, provide a well-rounded education, invest in implementing culturally responsive practices, and promote continuous improvement to close opportunity and achievement gaps for historically and currently underserved students.
