Breakfast/Lunch Program

The federal aid that allowed students to eat free school meals is no longer available for the 2022-2023 school year. School breakfast and lunch cost students:

- ⇒ Breakfast will cost \$2.25
- ⇒ Lunch will cost \$3.25
- ⇒ Milk without a meal will cost \$0.60

Oregon is participating in the Oregon Expanded Income Program (EIG). This program allows many more families not normally qualified for federal free and reduces meals to receive school meals at no charge. EIG is designed to proved over 62% of Oregon students with meals at no cost. Incoming 7th graders

Incoming 7th graders need a Tdap booster. This is a requirement by the Oregon Law for school attendance. Most students have 5 DTap (Diphtheria/Tetanus/Pertussis) vaccines, and need a Tdap booster for this age group. These boosters can be administered through a provider office and/or pharmacy. If your student is not up to date for required immunization, by February, they will be excluded from school on the exclusion date (the third Wednesday of February of each year).

Strengthening Rural Families

Strengthening families is a ten week class for adults and their young teens to attend together. Adults and Youth will learn ways to build healthy communication and relationships including how to identify their own strengths and connect socially and emotionally.
