PHS Wins OSAA Cup

PHS won the OSAA Cup for the second time for the 2021-2022 school year. The cup, previously known as the Oregonian Cup, is awarded based on excellence in athletics, academics, activities and sportsmanship. Schools in each classification are awarded points based on how well their athletic teams and activities do in state play-offs and the academic all-state program. There is also a sportsmanship component.

The OSAA Cup has been awarded 21 times since its creation.

Philomath also received the award for the 2010-2011 school year.
