I had the pleasure of sitting in on a Zoom session for each class this week. It was wonderful to watch all the learning going on! According to the Oregon Department of Education (ODE), student attendance includes both participation in class activities and/or interaction with a teacher or instructional assistant throughout the school day.

Interactions can be evidenced by any of the following:

1. Participating in a live Zoom class.
2. Posting completed coursework to Seesaw, or
3. Turning in completed coursework in your weekly packet on Mondays.

When there is no evidence of student interaction during a 24 hour period surrounding a scheduled school day as described, students are reported as absent for the day.

To maximize learning in a comprehensive distance-learning model, we highly encourage students and families to participate in ALL assigned activities each day.
