 - d. There's a head-and-shoulders view, with the entire face, both eyes, and hair clearly visible; head coverings worn for religious purposes are allowed. Otherwise, no hats or masks.
 - e. You're in focus.
 - f. There are no dark spots or shadows.
 - g. Attire is school appropriate (please refer to the Student Handbook, Dress Guidelines)


These photos are acceptable.



Common Mistakes

Here are examples of some common mistakes that result in faces not being fully visible and recognizable:

1. Your photo is too light or too dark.



2. Your photo is taken from too far away or too close.



3. Only part of your face can be seen (part or all of your face is covered, part or all of your head is cut off, you are shown in profile or three-quarter view).



4. Other common problems include other people being present in the picture and the picture not being of you. Remember, this photo will be in the PHS Yearbook!
