Passport News




We are excited to continue the Passport Program this year.

Each quarter, students can earn a Passport, which allows them special privileges and entrance to a quarterly celebration during school.

Here are the criteria as developed by the Passport Committee:

- No Discipline Actions (Detentions, Suspensions, Citations)
- Zero Unexcused Absences
- Meet Teacher-Set Expectations for Missing Work

A list of students who earned a Passport will be posted after each quarter.



Pre–Arranged Absences

Attending school is the first step of the learning process for students. Regular and punctual attendance is often

times the student's responsibility, but by Oregon law, it is the parent's responsibility to make sure students attend school.

The law states that any student may be excused from school by pre-arranged absence for the purpose of vacation, hunting, family reunion, etc. for a period of time " not to exceed five days in a term of three months or not to exceed ten days in any term of at least six months" (ORS 339.065) After the excused limit is exceeded, the absence will be coded as Pre-Arranged Unexcused.

Unexcused absences will affect admittance to quarterly Passport activities. All Pre-Arranged absences requests must be submitted to the school in writing prior to the planned absence. You may submit your request by emailing Chad Matthews at


