FlashAlert.net Notification Service

The Philomath School District has subscribed to an Internet-based system for delivering changes in schedule (such as delays or snow closures) to the news media.

Message delivery is being extended directly to the public through a system called FlashAlert. You are now able to self-register and manage up to three home or office emails. **Even faster** is the free iPhone/Android app *FlashAlert Messenger*, which allows the public to receive "push notifications" of your emergency messages - much faster and more reliable than text messages. You must click for the Android version; iOS (iPhone) version.

To register, use any browser except Internet Explorer

Go to www.FlashAlert.net

On the top menu bar, select "Manage Your Messages"

For new users, scroll down and click on "Create New Account"

- Select Eugene, Springfield, Roseburg, Albany, Corvallis
- Select our Organization (Benton County Schools).
- Select our Organization (Philomath School District)
- Enter your primary email address
- Subscribe
- Confirm your email address
- Create a password
- Click to receive a validation message
- Enter the code in the box from the message you receive via email
- Click Update

On the tabs, you can then add more email addresses (My Email Address), link phone apps (FlashAlert Messenger), review current subscriptions, add subscriptions, or change your password. The option to delete the account altogether is available as well.

Log Out (at top left from this screen).

All addresses registered on FlashAlert will remain confidential and shall not be released to any person or organization.

Once a year, you will receive an email at your primary address asking if you wish to continue your subscription.
