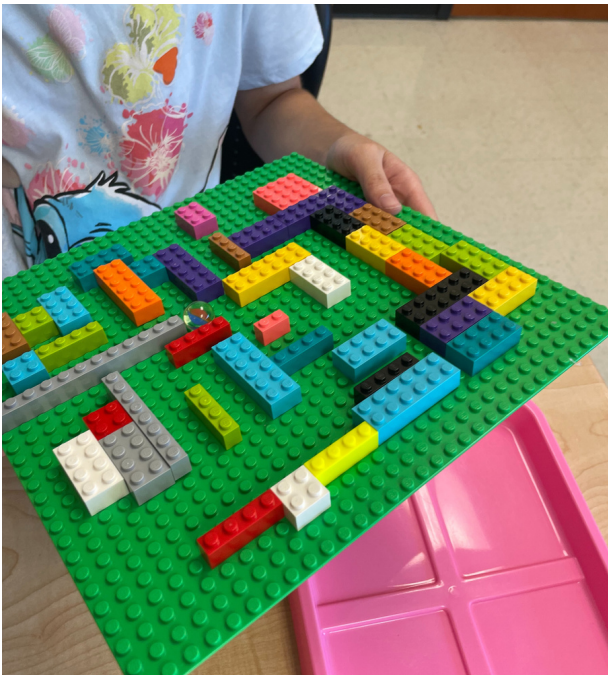

We will be offering the PSAT on October 25. Interested 10th and 11th grade students will sign up using [this link](#).

This year, a fee is required to take the test. The fee is \$18 and can be paid to the PHS main office. The test will be digital this year, and students will test using their school-issued Chromebooks. Additional information will be sent out to students who sign up as the test date approaches.
