Senior All Night Party registration now open



Seniors who are uncertain about future plans or need a backup post high school plan, please consider applying for LBCC's Early



Application (READ) program. The Roadrunner early application deadline is Thursday, Nov. 30. By applying early students receive support and priority scheduling for Fall of 2024. Additionally, eligible students who apply for the Oregon Promise can use funds to pay for college at LBCC for a certificate, short term program, degree program or transfer degree.

Create FSA ID to prepare for FAFSA

Seniors, If you haven't already, please take the time to create an FSA ID. Each student and *parent (for dependent students) must create a Federal Student Aid Identification (FSA ID) to securely log in and sign the FAFSA online. You can prepare for the FAFSA by creating your FSA ID before your application season opens.

*Parents who already have a FSA ID do not need to create a new one for each student. The FSA ID is assigned one time to each person for use throughout a lifetime.
