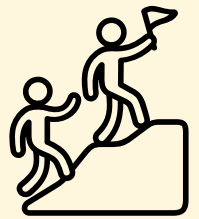
What drew you to ASB?

Cross Country to Host District Meet

Philomath High School will host the Oregon West Conference Cross Country Championships on Saturday at the Paul Mariman Memorial Course, with varsity races starting at 11:45 a.m. for boys and 12:20 p.m. for girls. The PHS girls team is heavily favored to win its 13th straight league title, led by standout sophomore Cassidy Smart, while the boys will battle Stayton, Newport, and Sweet Home for one of two automatic state berths. Senior Leo Pausch enters as the top-ranked boys runner in the conference, aiming to lead the Warriors back to state competition.

The Warriors finished fourth in the Oregon West Conference, narrowly missing the Class 4A playoffs despite ranking No. 9 in the state.
