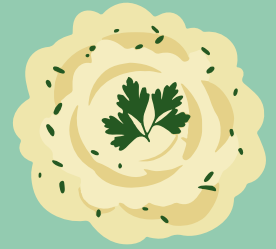


Holiday Meal Coming December 16

PHS Students Experience College Life at LBCC

Twenty-three Philomath High School students got a taste of college life in October when they participated in Linn-Benton Community College's "Roadrunner Experience" event with Kim St. Clair, Amber Ellis, and Leslie Adams.

The program gives area high school seniors a chance to experience what it's like to be a Roadrunner by touring the campus, participating in mini lecture classes taught by LBCC faculty members, engaging in a resource fair, and attending workshops on financial aid, scholarship and the application process.

Lunch was provided for all participants as they explored potential academic pathways and got a real feel for college life. This hands-on experience helps students envision their future in higher education and familiarizes them with the college environment before making the transition from high school.
