## Welcome Class of 2027



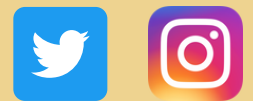
8th Grader's visited the High School Wednesday, April 12, to tour the building, learn about HS life, activity and opportunities that they will experience here next year.
