POSITION: Spanish Teacher (1.0 FTE) - Philomath High School

DESCRIPTION: Instruction of Spanish, grades 9-12

QUALIFICATIONS: Oregon Certification as determined by Oregon Teacher Standards & Practices Commission (TSPC) with Spanish Endorsement. Familiarity with COFLT and ACTFL proficiency assessment.

- Develop student skills, knowledge, concepts, generalizations, principles, appreciations and attitudes that are necessary to meet standard appropriate student outcomes.
- Adjust flexible strategies and behaviors to the situation and student needs
- Provide a classroom climate conducive to learning - stressing safety, responsibility and skill learning.

- Provide a classroom environment of active learning emphasizing student participation and performance.
- Assess, prescribe and evaluate student performance based upon objective centered instruction and proficiency.
